



Heart Pumping Action – July Race Report

6th August 2011 saw the Engen Polo Cup head back to Port Elizabeth for the 5th round of the Wesbank Super Series and what a day it turned out to be with intermittent rain and changing weather conditions putting the drivers and team to the test, but boy did they come out on top.

Devin Robertson Big Boss Auto/Sparco Polo qualified with two pole positions and went on to claim another two wins. Devin is now 57 points ahead in the championship with four rounds of racing to go. Devin has already achieved nine pole positions and nine wins from ten heats this season and he has definitely been the class of the field this year. At only 19 years old he has shown the maturity to tackle the toughest field in the country and come out on top. “This year has been an awesome year so far and I will keep on with the hard work and preparation as the results show it is definitely well worth it.”

To add to the achievement for the day, Dewald Brummer at only 15 years old made his first appearance on the podium. Dewald in his Horne/MOMO Polo qualified in 4th position which put him in the top six draw for the grid. Dewald had what must be two of the best races of his life so far and finished 2nd in the first heat to Devin giving the team a 1st, 2nd and then 3rd in the second heat giving the team a first and second overall for the day. Dewald led the first heat for a few laps and the top class finish for the day will give his confidence a huge boost as the team heads to East London for the next round of the championship.



Dewald received the Driver of the Day award and the good haul of points saw him move up to 8th in the overall championship, currently second in the Rookies. It was an excellent weekend for the team.

30 July 2011

Devin Robertson raced the Datsun at Zwartkops in the Pre '84 classic thoroughbreds achieving 2 class wins and a 1st overall for the day. The historic series has big fields and a great atmosphere with some really awesome race cars out on track. It was great to see the Datsun mixing it up with the Porsches and other big powered cars in the field and showing them a thing or two. Well done Devin. Devin also received Driver of the Day.

23rd July 2011

Saturday, 23rd July 2011 saw the team split again with Go Kart Racing at Zwartkops where Jagger Robertson 5years old had another good day in the driver's seat. Having only started this season he is fast coming to grips with the traffic and improves his lap times every time out. He achieved a 01:09 and is continuously closing the gap to the front of the field. Jagger finished 7th overall for the day after finishing 7th, 9th and 7th in the heats.

At the same time the regional series raced at Kyalami and with eight drivers pitting in the Big Boss Auto pit the atmosphere was great and the racing even better.

Justin Robertson, Big Boss Auto BMW M3 qualified 2nd in his class and achieved a first and 2nd in the two heats finishing 1st overall for the day. Beating him in qualifying and heat two was Devin Robertson in the Mini Cooper Turbo and achieving a lap record at the same time with a 01:52:4 for a fwd car at Kyalami, probably one of the fastest fwd times around the track ever.

Second in heat one and 3rd in the second heat saw Rod Cole Edwards in the Radical Investments Porsche GT3 finish 2nd overall and saw the podium full of Big Boss Auto Drivers.



Dewald Brummer driving the Horne Formula Vee in the Formula Monoposto series raced well through the day and finished with two class wins and 1st overall for the day. Riding the Formula Vee against the more powerful GTI vehicles kept him chasing the pace and improving times all day.

A new member to the team is Bevan Williams who competed in the Formula M class of the single seater race having some mechanical problems during the day he showed true grit and determination to still finish on the podium with a third overall for the day. Bevan will also be competing in the VW Challenge in a class C Golf 1 backed by Industrial Engine Parts and MOMO.

Johan Krynauw qualified pole position in the Silver Cup and finished 2nd in the race winning his class for a first time out at Kyalami. The team was very happy with his performance and his continuous effort in improving his car Johan has progressed from the Oval Track and has been showing great form on the long circuit.

The team catered for \pm 50 guests on the day and would like to thank Radical Investments for seeing to the catering for the day. Everybody had a good time and enjoyed watching some action filled racing. Thank you to Rockstar Energy Drinks for the facilities provided and their involvement on the day.
